

Moment 2 - Before a clean or aseptic technique

Goal: Whenever you do a clean or aseptic task you perform Hand Hygiene.

- Moment 2 tasks usually follow moment 1
- You may be able to combine moment 1 and moment 2 and do hand hygiene once as long as you do not touch anything in between

Healthcare Environment: Environment beyond the resident's immediate area. In a single room this is outside the room. In a multi-bed room this is everything outside the resident's bed area

Moment 2 examples:

- Prior to a dressing change
- Prior to preparing medications
- Prior to taking medications out of Pyxis machines
- Prior to instilling eye/ear drops
- Prior to starting a peripheral IV
- Prior to oral care
- Prior to feeding a resident
- Prior to setting up a patient's food tray
- Prior to Subcutaneous/Intramuscular injections
