

Hand Hygiene—4 Moments Campaign

After patient or patient environment contact.

For example:

- After taking a blood pressure, temperature or pulse. After touching a wheelchair or walker.
- In a single room this is everything in the resident's room
- In a multi-bed room this is the area inside the resident's curtain (touch the resident and then the curtain = missed hand hygiene opportunity).
- In an ambulatory setting, the resident environment is the area that may come into contact with the resident within their cubicle.

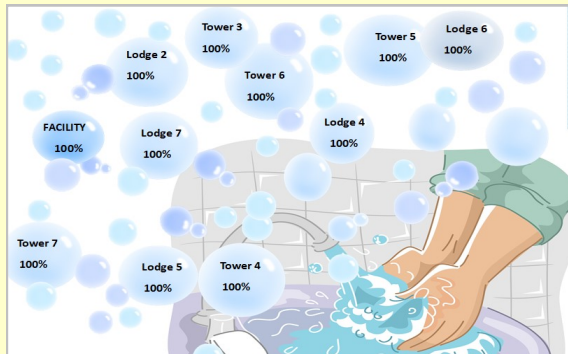
