

# **Volunteers with Parkinson's Disease Needed for Research Study on Mild Cognitive Impairment**

We are currently seeking individuals diagnosed with Parkinson's disease to participate in a clinical research study looking at mild cognitive impairment in Parkinson's disease.

## **Purpose:**

This research is being done because there is no effective treatment for mild cognitive impairment in Parkinson's disease. Recent studies suggest that a painless, non-invasive brain stimulation technique may enhance cognitive function by normalizing abnormal brain activities.

## **Procedure:**

- Clinical & neuropsychological exams (pre/ post intervention and 2 month follow-up)
- Magnetic Resonance Imaging (twice; 1.5 hours/session)
- 18 in-home brain stimulation sessions (over 4 week period)
